COURT ORDER

In relation to the Statement of Claim presented this day on behalf of the Plaintiffs, the supporting evidence and the failure of the Defendants to appear, we the jury find the Defendants guilty on the following counts:

Personation - committed by impersonating another and by falsely assuming a certain position and status in order to obtain and gain benefit and advantage, namely diminishing the capacity of man to a fiction with no life, known as person, a crown construct.

Subrogation - where the Plaintiff had been substituted for a legal fiction with no life, to defraud, gain benefit and to unlawfully obtain property from him.

Fraud – both civil and criminal fraud have been committed to secure an unfair and unlawful gain, this also deprived the Plaintiff of his inherent birth rights.

Theft – the theft of the Plaintiffs personal property which had been removed with the use of fraudulent documents.

Kidnapping – the unlawful kidnapping and detention of the Plaintiffs nephew.

Unlawful use of the plaintiff's property – the unlawful use of the fictitious name which was owned by the Plaintiff.

It is hereby ordered that after a unanimous decision of the jury that Sheriff William Ireland, Sheriff David Pender & Sheriff Thomas McCartney are each liable for the following amount (£25,000) to cover the unlawful use of the Plaintiffs Fictitious Name. This sum has been determined by the jury and must be paid to the Plaintiff within a period of fourteen (14) days from the signed receipt of this order.

It is further ordered that the family members listed below are each to be paid £25,000 compensation, this sum (£125,000) to be met by all named Defendants (£25,000 each). This sum has been determined by the jury and must be paid to the Plaintiff within a period of fourteen (14) days from the signed receipt of this order:

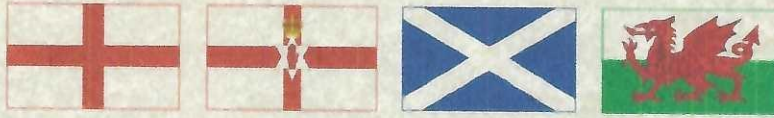
It is further ordered that each Defendant will be required to pay a fine of £75,000 and must be removed from their current positions immediately. This sum has been determined by the jury and must be paid to the Plaintiff within a period of fourteen (14) days from the signed receipt of this order.

It is further ordered that the Defendants are to return the Plaintiffs nephew, within twenty-four hours of receiving this court order, to the family. Failure to return this child within the twenty-four hours would then incur a charge of £1.00 per minute, to be backdated to 12 o'clock noon, on the day that he was first removed. This additional charge would have to be met by all Defendants, each having a liability for 20 pence per minute.

In the event that the Plaintiffs nephew is not returned within twenty-four hours from the signed receipt of this court order, the additional charge mentioned above will be added to the total due.

This Court Order is effective as of this date and will remain in force until such time as it has been enforced. This order is issued under the authority of this Common Law Court and jus gentium, the Law of Nations.
